- → Principal's Report (Dr. Simpkins)
- → Tier 1 instruction:
- 1. Benchmark literacy report; Literacy core team consists of 1 teacher per grade level which ensures the benchmark is being used correctly and conducts walkthroughs including student engagement (all were positive results of the walkthroughs);
- 2. Math: Ready Set Math (1 teacher per grade level who is trained in this)
- 3. SOAR: 1/2 hr. throughout the day for each grade level (math group and math challenges); High Impact Tutors are trained in Lexia, UFIy, etc for those who need that level of intervention daily
- → Caring Culture Staff:
- 4. It is our 3rd year implementing RULER (evidence based program out of Yale, partnering with UVA) to phase in student's ability to utilize their emotions to self regulate
- 5. Charter: how to be a good citizen, character building and own responsibility
- 6. Valentines of Kindness hearts on the walls for the staff to support each other
- 7. Kudos ways to recognize teachers and thanking them
- 8. New Teacher Mentoring Program new teachers are linked with a veteran teacher
- → Caring Culture Students:
- 9. SEL social emotional lessons are embedded in classes; Mood meters and RULER integration
- 10. Morning meeting responsive classroom learn social skills and classroom community
- 11. Best Buddies Supported by the PTO; program pairs the student mentors with mentees (students who have disabilities or those who need support with social skills)
- 12. Green Team County wide program; Students experience eco-friendly practices like recycling; Teacher Mrs. Hodge
- 13. Ambassadors purple star military new students ensure the new student has a buddy and someone who is looking out for them at lunch, recess, etc.
- 14. Attendance looking out for students who are not present; admin gets together to have discussions with those families to help them get the children in school
